RESOLUTION NO. 79 ✓

TO INFORM THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR, BFD, QUEZON CITY THE STATUS OF THE FOREST RESERVED AREA IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, has received a copy of Memorandum from the Regional Director, BFD, Region IV, Quezon City to Senior Forester Constantine Pattaguan, Team Leader CLCT, NO. 81 BFD, Region IV, Quezon City to conduct an investigation over the recommended area in this municipality for release to alienable and disposable lands;

WHEREAS, while waiting for the result of the investigation, the Sangguniang Bayan has passed Resolution No. 57 dated September 17, 1986 recommending Barangay San Isidro, Benli, Bagong Sikat, Cambunang, Cabugao, Nasucob and San Juan for release to agricultural purposes;

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 286, dated August 15, 1964 had reserved Southern Mindoro as Forest Areas and the municipality of Bulalacao is within that reservation area;

WHEREAS, the Forest areas in the Barangays hereinabove-mentioned are already denuded and now occupied by thousands of farmers and planted to rice, corn, coconuts, bamboos, bananas, mangoes and other fruit trees, which products were hauled from farm to market or transported to other municipalities or to Batangas for commercial purposes;

WHEREAS, lands covered by Forest within the reservation area of this municipality could be found in the interior part between Occidental and Oriental Mindoro;

WHEREAS, the main objective of the National government under the new era to solve insurgency is to give employment to unemployed and lands to the landless;

NOW, THEREFORE, resolved, as it is hereby resolved, to inform the the Regional Director, BFD, Region IV, Quezon City that the reservation area in this municipality are already denuded and therefore recommended for release to alienable and disposable lands;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished, the Regional Director, BFD Region IV, Quezon City for information and consideration.

On motion of Hon. Ignacio Silang, seconded by Hon. Angelico Lignes, the above resolution was... UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.
