

ORDINANCE NO. 070

PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE ISSUANCE OF MAYOR'S LICENSE FOR THE OPERATION OF FISHING VESSELS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. All fishing boats with gross weight of three (3) tonnage and below, either motorized or non-motorized, operating within the municipal waters of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro are hereby required to secure Municipal Fishing Boat License from the Office of the Municipal Mayor;

SECTION 2. Issuance of the Municipal Fishing Boat License by the Municipal Mayor shall be governed by the rules and regulations hereunder prescribed, to wit:

- A. No Fishing Boat License shall be issued to any person without prior securing inspection permit and the recommendation for approval from the Municipal Agricultural Officer; Provided, that barangay clearance from the barangay where the boat is regularly docked shall first be obtained by the applicant;
- B. The Municipal Agricultural Officer shall require the owners of all fishing boats with three gross weight of three (3) tons and below to secure clearance or inspection permit from his office before any fishing operation can be made;
- C. A party required to secure a clearance or inspection permit under this ordinance shall file an application therefor with the Municipal Agricultural Officer. The application shall state:
  - a. The name, address and other pertinent circumstances of the persons, in case of an individual or, in the case of a firm, association, partnership or other entity the name, address and other pertinent circumstances of the president, manager or officer in charge;
  - b. Measurement of the boat including gross weight tonnage and built;
  - c. Type and brand name, horsepower, serial number and date of acquisition of the engine;
  - d. Type and color and date of acquisition of the boat;
  - e. Certificate of ownership, deed of sale and other pertinent documents attesting that the banca or the engine is legally acquired;

- D. The owner of the banca shall notify the Office of the Municipal Agricultural Officer in case of the vessel repair or change of engine.
- E. The Office of the Municipal Agricultural Officer shall exercise the powers, duties and responsibilities provided under this ordinance. Specifically, this office shall be responsible for the issuance of Municipal Fishing Vessel numbers; Provided, that the following code as to the barangays where the bancas originated shall be adopted, to wit:

- F. For the issuance of clearance/inspection permit required under this ordinance, the application fee of twenty-five pesos (P25.00) shall be charged, payable to the Municipal Treasurer or to his duly authorized representatives. Non-motorized boats are exempted from payment of this fee;

SECTION 3. There shall be collected the following fees for the issuance of Municipal Fishing Boat License from the owner of such fishing boat, either motorized or non-motorized being operated in this municipality on the amount indicated hereunder:

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| a. Fishing boat of two (2) tons but not more than three (3) tons . . . . . | 100.00 |
| b. Fishing boat of one (1) ton but not more than two (2) tons . . . . .    | 75.00  |
| c. Motorized fishing boat of one (1) ton and below . . . . .               | 50.00  |
| d. Non-motorized fishing boat . . . . .                                    | 10.00  |

SECTION 4. Any violation hereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) but not exceeding Two Thousand and Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) or by an imprisonment of not less than fifteen (15) days but not more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court;

SECTION 5. All ordinances inconsistent hereof are hereby repealed, modified accordingly;

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting.
