RESOLUTION NO. 02-09-185

REQUESTING THE HONORABLE ALFONSO V. UMALI, JR. TO GRANT ONE COLD STORAGE FACILITIES UNDER POST HARVEST INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITY SUPPORT TO AGR/FISHERY DEVELOPMENT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture (DA) in coordination with the National Agriculture and Fishery Council (NAFC) executed the program named as PostHarvest Infrastructure and Facility support to Agri-Fishery Development to be implemented directly the Department of Agriculture – Regional Field Units;

“WHEREAS, such program is adopted in order to provide the necessary Postharvest infrastructure and facility support to enable small farmers and fisher folks greater access to technologies that improve the handling, storage, processing and distribution of agriculture and fishery products;

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, being engaged in fishery business where eight (8) out of fifteen (15) component barangays, belong to the so-called coastal barangays and considering further that transportation of marine goods is not sufficiently provided for, either on account of lack of immediate and efficient transportation service due to road condition or Inavailability of transport vehicles;

“WHEREAS, this Municipality has identified Cold Storage Facility as one of the best tools that could help our small businessmen engaged in the buy and selling of marine produce such as fish, crabs, shrimps, lobster et cetera which are being transported to Malabon, Cavite and to many other areas of Luzon;

"WHEREAS, upon knowing that the Department of Agriculture is allocating under per identified Congressional District for the establishment of Post Harvest project, the Municipality of Bulalacao is hereby taking the grant opportunity to request its Congressman, Alfonso V. Umali, Jr., to consider Cold Storage Facilities for Bulalacao of this Program;


