MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 25-02-408

**AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING KATUWANG SA DIWA AT
GAWA PARA SA MASAGANANG ANI AT MATAAS NA KITA (KADIWA)
NG PANGULO (KNP) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO,
PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

WHEREAS, in accordance to 1996 World Food Summit, food security is defined when all people, at all times, have physical and economic access to sufficient safe and nutritious food that meets their dietary needs and food preferences for an active and healthy life;

WHEREAS, economic growth is determined by upturn in investments, productivity, and consumer spending;

WHEREAS, local government units have a direct impact on the local economy by encouraging business location and incubation, supporting enterprise development, linking local produce to markets, and facilitating job creation and livelihood development leading to sustainable local economic activities:

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2024-003 orders all LGUs to set-up the KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP) in their respective localities in partnership with the Department of Agriculture (DA), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and the Department of the Interior and Local Government;

WHEREAS, the KNP is part of the government's efforts in ensuring stable food supply and affordable products by enabling farmers to sell directly to consumers by eliminating market layers;

WHEREAS, the KNP also ensures value chain development by connecting farmers to markets and ensuring that the value generated by agricultural products is retained within the local economy;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro supports the KADIWA program which is at the core of President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr.'s food security agenda that drives inclusive growth in the agriculture sector while strengthening the nation's supply chains;

WHEREAS, it is ideal and orderly to institutionalize the KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP) that will secure the availability and affordability of food in the community which can boost the economic stability of the municipality as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, that: 

Section 1. Statement of Policy. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to ensure food security of every Bulalacaonon that adhere to the programs and directives of the national government which aims to empower the farmers and provide affordable food to consumers.

Section 2. Title. This Ordinance is entitled as stated and shall be also known as "2025 KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP) Ordinance of Bulalacao".

Section 3. When to be Conducted. The KNP shall be conducted once a month in the date and area to be assigned and designated by the Local Chief Executive.

Section 4. Product Clusters. The KNP shall have three market areas or product clusters, as follows:

- a. Agricultural produce such as rice, vegetables, fruit grown by farmers from the various barangays in the municipality.
- b. Processed goods, both food and non-food, the Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSME).
- c. Mercato stalls (ready-to-eat) food for micro-enterprises.

Section 5. Responsibilities of the Local Government Unit (LGU).
The LGU through the Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) together with the Municipal Market Administrator shall have the following responsibilities in the operation of the KNP:

- a. Lead in the overall management and operation of the KADIWA.
- b. Facilitate the invitation and mobilization of local micro-entrepreneurs, cooperatives and MSMEs to sell local produce products in the KADIWA.
- c. Identify and secure a suitable venue for the KADIWA.
- d. Assign stalls and provide any logistical support to participating sellers.
- e. Promote the KADIWA to the community/buyers through information campaign.
- f. Invite the community/buyers to participate during the KADIWA Day through information campaign (i.e. posting of tarpaulins or streamers and utilizing the social media).
- g. Coordinate with concerned offices and/or agencies for guidance in handling, operating and managing the KADIWA, food and market supply, prospective sellers, and other arrangements needed and for the maintenance of sanitation, peace, order, and public safety every KNP Day.

Section 6. Responsibility of the Barangays. All barangays are encouraged to provide the necessary support in the transport of products and goods of their residents participating in the KNP.

The Punong Barangays are enjoined to promote participation in the KNP among associations, cooperatives, farmers, fisherfolk and MSMEs in their respective barangays.

Section 7. Focal Person. The Municipal Mayor shall designate a KNP Focal Person who shall come from the MAO and perform the following functions:

- a. Take charge in the overall implementation of the KNP.
- b. Keep record of data such as the number of participants and the amount of revenue generated during KNP Day, among others and submit the same to the DA and DTI copy furnished the DILG.
- c. Perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned by the Municipal Mayor.

Section 8. Fee Exemption. All the KNP participants shall be exempted in all fees or permits as required by the LGU.


Section 9. Appropriation. The fund needed for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be included in the General Appropriation Fund Annual Budget of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro. The amount for years after 2025 shall be based on the budget proposal to be submitted by Office of the Municipal Mayor. The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Municipal Budget Officer shall ensure that the budget necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance is included in yearly appropriation. The fund allocated for this purpose shall not be allowed for realignment and not be certified as savings unless it served its purpose already within a particular fiscal year.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. Any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


Section 11. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.


Section 12. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.


