" RESOLUTION NO. 021

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN, THROUGH THE JAPAN INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AGENCY (JICA) TO GRANT ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO BY DONATING ONE (1) UNIT OF GRADER, ONE (1) UNIT OF DUMP TRUCK AND ONE MULTI-PURPOSE SERVICE VEHICLE

"WHEREAS, Japan, in the name of goodwill and international solidarity has been extending packages of grant assistance to the Philippines, to help the latter on its development, reconstruction and rehabilitation efforts;

"WHEREAS, Japanese Ambassador to the Philippines Hirokazu Arai said last October 23, 1992 that " I can assure you that my government will remain focused on directly addressing the plight of farmers in rural areas and the urban poor through extending grant aid to the Philippines;"

"WHEREAS, the local leadership is aware that to effect development, the Government must first lay down the foundation of progress namely improved irrigation system, effective communication system and most of all an efficient transportation system such as farm to market roads and other related basic services;

"WHEREAS, notwithstanding the genuine commitment of the local municipal officials to provide those services, still financial constraint becomes the major hindrance in the realization of their long time dream of advancement;

"WHEREAS, the humble Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, one of the 150 Low Income Municipalities under Executive Order No. 390 hopes that the goodwill of the Japanese people will help the economically affected people of this Municipality to overcome the difficulties and move towards better future;

WHEREFORE, upon motion duly seconded; be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Bayan to request the Government of Japan through the Japan International Coordinating Agency (JICA) to grant assistance to the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro by way of donating one (1) unit of grader, one(1) unit of dump truck and one (1) unit of multi-purpose service vehicle;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished the Japanese Embassy in the Republic of the Philippines and the Japan International Coordinating Agency (JICA) for their information and kindest approval.
