"WHEREAS, Section 386 of Republic Act No.7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 and Article 14 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations provide that a barangay may be created in the indigenous cultural communities by an Act of Congress upon recommendation of the Local Government Unit where the cultural community is located;

"WHEREAS, Sitio Yunot at Barangay Nasucob, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro expressed its desire to be created as a new barangay by virtue of Resolution No. 01, series of 1999 which was submitted to this Sanggunian for recommendation;

"WHEREAS, Sitio Yunot and the sixteen (16) adjacent sitios at Barangays Nasucob, San Juan and Benli, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro are composed of Hanunuo-Mangyans are desirous of becoming a new barangay in order to be benefited of the basic services which they claimed are deprived of them;


