EARNESTLY REQUESTING DIRECTOR ROSA E. MACAS, BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES, REGION IV TO SEND TECHNICAL PERSONS TO EXAMINE AND EVALUATE THE ALLEGED ILL EFFECT OF THE CHEMICAL CONTENT OF THE MALAMPAYA GAS PIPELINES TO THE AQUA-MARINE RESOURCES AND DETRIORATION OF SEAWEEDES FARMING AT SITIO LIWAGAO, BARANGAY MAASIN, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the discovery of the natural gas reserves in Palawan by the Shell Philippines Exploration caused the construction and operation of an offshore pipelines off the coast of the Province of Oriental Mindoro more particularly at the Municipality of Bulalacao;

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro poses no objection on the project believing that it will not cause any destruction to the fishing industry and other similar activities.


"WHEREAS, however, the promise of the Shell Philippines Exploration for a sustainable development was replaced by a gloomy sense of apprehension when the fishfolks at Sitio Liwagao, Maasin, Municipality of Bulalacao observed the gradual destruction of seaweeds and deterioration of marine resources at the area where the pipes were layed,


