EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE ABS-CBN BANTAY BATA 163, CHANNEL 2,
QUEZON CITY TO EXTEND THE NECESSARY ASSISTANCE TO
EMMANUEL LAGURAS WHO IS PRESENTLY CONFINED AT BATANGAS
REGIONAL HOSPITAL, BATANGAS CITY

‘WHEREAS, Emmanuel Laguras, a Grade VI pupil at the Bulalacao Elementary
School, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro fell down from a running double tire jeep in the
afternoon of February 24, 2001;

‘WHEREAS, such accident brought Emmanuel a severe head injury described as
fractured skull bone and left shoulder and arm dislocation which made him comatose for
four days;

‘WHEREAS, Emmanuel was first rushed to the Bulalacao Community Hospital
but due to insufficiency of medical equipments and medicines, he was transferred to
Mercado General Hospital in Tanauan, Batangas for closer and further medical treatment
but after three days, his family brought him back home here in Bulalacao for they did not
see any sign of recovery on him;

‘WHEREAS, Emmanuel was brought back to Bulalacao Community Hospital
and miraculously after one day of confinement, he managed to open his eyes, move his

legs and open his mouth when somebody talks to him to which Dr. Rey Asignacion, the resident physician advised his family to transfer him to a more advanced and modern hospital in Manila but because of financial constraints, he was brought to Batangas Regional Hospital in Batangas City where he is presently confined


'WHEREAS, Mang Esto, Emmanuel's father is a marginal farmer and whose family is considered to be indigent is begging for financial assistance to defray the medical expenses of his son who remains almost unconscious for more than a month now;


