EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE ROBERTO S. SEBASTIAN,
SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, THRU UNDERSECRETARY
ROLIBO "BONG" IGNACIO, FOR FUND TO FINANCE THE CONSTRUCTION
OF FARM TO MARKET ROADS AND FISH PORT IN THE MUNICIPALITY
OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro
is a very depressed agricultural town included among the
Pro-Poor Municipalities declared under Executive Order
No. 370;

"WHEREAS, the absence of available farm to market roads
coupled with the lack of a fish port compounded the common
plight of the marginal farmers and fishermen in terms
of systematic delivery and transportation of their produce;

"WHEREAS, the availability of an effective and functioning
farm to market roads as well as a fish port would
trigger various agricultural activities among the farming
and fishing sectors, thereby boosting the whole economic
status of this municipality;

"WHEREAS, the main advantages of giving priority in the
identified farm to market roads and the construction of
fish port are seen to benefit the constituents of this
municipality, in this wise;

1. agricultural activities of the outlying barangays would be activated;
2. the value of agricultural produce would be increased trading;
3. tax collection and shipping will be easier and systematic;

- 4. private individuals would be encouraged to put more money in fishing ventures, thereby reviving the fishing industry and increasing the municipality revenue source;
- 5. increase the value of agricultural produce both from farming and fishing, and eventually improve the marginal farmers and fishermen's living standard; Now, therefore, be it;

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To earnestly request the Honorable Roberto S. Sebastian, Secretary, Department of Agriculture, thru Undersecretary, Rolleo "Bong" Ignacio, for fund to finance the construction of farm to market roads and fish port in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to let copies of this resolution be furnished Undersecretary Rolleo "Bong" Ignacio, Department of Agriculture, DA Building, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City, for his information, reference and kindest approval;
