ROMULO, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY AND CONCURRENT CHAIRMAN OF THE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON DEVOLUTION TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (Php10,000,000.00) FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENTS AND MEDICINES FOR THE MEDICAL OUTREACH PROGRAM, MUNICIPAL HEALTH CENTER COMMUNITY HOSPITAL AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**




