RESOLUTION NO. 04-09-113

ADOPTING THE PROVISIONS IN WHOLE OF THE ARTICLE 176 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 209, BETTER KNOWN AS THE FAMILY CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES AMENDING R.A. NO. 9255, DATED FEBRUARY 21, 2004, ALLOWING CHILDREN TO USE THE SURNAME OF THEIR BIOLOGICAL FATHER

"WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 1, series 2004 by the Office of the Civil Registrar General, promulgated the **RULES OF REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF R.A. NO. 9255** also known as an Act Allowing the illegitimate children to use the surname of their father amending for the purpose of Article 176 of Executive Order No. 209, other known as the Family Code of the Philippines;

"WHEREAS, under such Executive Order, it was so provided that the father, mother, child of age or the guardian may file the public document of **Affidavit to Use the Surname of the Father (AUSF)** in order for the child to use the surname of the father;

"WHEREAS, allowing a child not yet registered the surname of the father shall be entered as the last name of the child in the Certificate of Live Birth, an that documents (AUSF) shall be recorded in the Register of Births in the Local Civil Registrar; and therefore shall established the authenticity and a certain the truth of the facts stated in the Affidavit and all the documents presented;


"WHEREAS, the principal reason for adopting this specific Order shall redound both to the emotional and psychological benefits of the child and of the father whose alien identity shall now be particularly and absolutely identified upon the admission and recognition of the paternity of the child and his filiation;

"WHEREAS, seeing the beauty, the prudence and humanitarian considerations, allied with this very sensitive familial issue, the Sangguniang Bayan, respects the constitutional mandate that the family is the basic institution of the State; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Adopt the provisions in whole of the Article 176 of Executive Order No. 209, better known as the Family Code of the Philippines amending R.A. No. 9255, dated February 21, 2004, allowing children to use the surname of their biological father;


