RESOLUTION NO. 03-02-028

REQUESTING THE COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICER, SAN MARIANO, ROXAS, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO STOP ISSUING PERMITS AND CERTIFICATE OF VERIFICATIONS TO CHARCOAL MANUFACTURERS, DEALERS AND OTHERS WITHIN THE AREA OF JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO AS AN EXEMPTION TO DENR MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 97-23 DATED, NOVEMBER 27, 1997 AND DENR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 96-26 DATED, SEPTEMBER 10, 1996

"WHEREAS, the total stop in the manufacture and shipment of charcoal at the Municipality of Bulalacao has been an oft-repeated request of this Sanggunian who are aware and afraid of the consequences which may lead to endanger lives and properties;

"WHEREAS, it is sadly observed that the thick and virgin forest of Bulalacao before which is rich in different varieties of birds and animal species is now replaced by a barren and devastated view of loss and hopelessness;


"WHEREAS, the destruction of our ecological system through the continuous charcoal making would be a grave sin to the next generations ahead of us for these natural resources were not inherited from our ancestors rather, they are borrowed from them so that we should return it in a much better condition;



RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Request the Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer, San Mariano, Roxas, Oriental Mindoro to stop issuing permits and certificate of verifications to charcoal manufacturers, dealers and others within the area of jurisdiction of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro as an exemption to DENR Memorandum Circular No. 97-23 dated, November 27, 1997 and DENR Administrative Order No. 96-26 dated, September 10, 1996;
