RESOLUTION NO. 06-01-004

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, REGION IV TO ALLOCATE MEDICINES FOR THE INDIGENT RESIDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1986 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

"WHEREAS, it is sadly observed that life becomes more difficult each day that people could hardly cope up with their basic needs, particularly access to affordable medicines and basic medical services;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Health Office at this Municipality which is manned by one physician, two nurses and a few number of midwives could not fully deliver effective and efficient medical services needed by the residents due to lack of medicines and inavailability of medical equipments ;


"WHEREAS, being the Pro-poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro which is composed of a population of a 20% Hanunuo Mangyans could not immediately augment the appropriation for health services, it, being hounded with financial constraint ;


"WHEREAS, aware of the alarming rate of the widespread of fatal and contagious diseases like dengue and malaria which kills precious human lives, the availability of medicines and medical equipments in the Municipal Health Office is indispensable; Now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Regional Director, Department of Health, Region IV to allocate medicines for the indigent residents of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;


