### RESOLUTION NO. 07-09-077

EARNESTLY REQUESTING HER EXCELLENCY GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO TO KINDLY GRANT TWO (2) UNITS (4 x 4) SERVICE VEHICLES FOR THE USE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro lies on the southern tips of the Island of Mindoro whose rugged terrains and rough roads make it doubly hard to travel for private individuals and government employees and officials alike who are mandated to reach out to their constituents;

"WHEREAS, delivery of basic services to the people living in the remote areas becomes difficult task due to certain transportation problems such as road conditions and availability of suitable vehicles;

"WHEREAS, we have witnessed it on TV sets, heard it over the radios and read on the dailies that a number of confiscated/impounded vehicles were destroyed by the elements of Bureau of Customs presumably for non-payment of prescribed tariff impositions, and that it was a form of punishment against economic saboteurs;

"WHEREAS, this Sanggunian was of the opinion that it must had been more prudent if those destroyed/confiscated vehicles were distributed to impoverished local government units in order to augment their insufficiency of vehicles that could be used in their daily undertakings of governmental duties and functions;

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao fully supports the project and programs of the President as manifested by the big margin garnered by the Administration candidates in the previous elections, and of course the President herself during the last presidential election;


"WHEREAS, the continued mutual support and cooperation enjoyed by and between the national head-ships and local officials provide ordinary people with a glimpse of hope towards prosperity and brighter future,


