RESOLUTION NO. 09-08-093

EXPRESSING THE DEEPEST SYMPATHY AND HEARTFELT CONDOLENCES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE CORAZON C. AQUINO, FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES

"WHEREAS, the year 1986 shall be remembered when Filipino transformed the political landscape and the promise of a new life as a nation when the so-called People Power Revolution, now known as EDSA 1, forced the deposed late dictator Ferdinand E. Marcos through the leadership of Corazon C. Aquino, fondly referred to as Tita Cory, that restored the fundamental tenets of democracy and freed of the millions of Filipinos long oppressed and denied with basic human rights;

"WHEREAS, as far as most historians are concerned Filipino women who joined the Revolution did so mainly as the dutiful wives, sisters, mothers or daughters of Katipuneros, in our contemporary age President Corazon C. Aquino was an epitome of all those: widow of the late Senator Benigno "Ninoy" S. Aquino and a loving mother and sister not only to her siblings but to the entire Filipino nation that was craving for a unifying force that galvanized peoples from different economic strata to work for a common cause;

"WHEREAS, people from all walks of life are so thankful for President Aquino, mainly because she restored constitutional democracy; as a mark of her sincerity and strong commitment to democracy in our country she started its restoration by causing the drafting of the 1987 Constitution which substantially reduced the presidential powers but at the same time expand civil rights and social justice system;

"WHEREAS, during her term as President of the Republic steps have been taken to energize the bureaucracy by way of intensifying a lean, honest, moral, simple and result-oriented government;

"WHEREAS, on a general view, President Corazon C. Aquino could be described in a multitude of ways, "The Icon of 1986 EDSA Revolution", "A True President of the Republic of the Philippines and of the entire Southeast Asia", "Mother of Democracy", "The First Woman among others, but for many of us she was simply Tita Cory who led us during the times of turbulence, when our democratic institutions and basic human rights were threatened; the woman who brought back the democracy the Filipinos enjoy now but foremost among her characteristics worthy of emulation by our present and future leaders were her simplicity, fairness, frugality, wisdom, calmness in times of adversity and unquestionable democracy;

"WHEREAS, in fine, words are not enough to describe the value and meaning of Former Corazon C. Aquino's life mean to every Filipino, one thing is certain for everyone of us that we lost a leader, a mother an icon and a paragon of virtue, humility and sincerity, characteristics she left us as her eternal legacy;

"WHEREAS, while futile it may be to attempt to deflect those the sorrows of those she left behind from the grief a loss, so painful and excruciating yet, we must try to tender to them the consolation that shoe now lies in the hands of our Creator and her memories live forever in the hearts and minds of every Filipino; Now, therefore, be it






