ABAD, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT TO KINDLY GRANT FISCAL AUTONOMY TO BULALACAO CENTRAL SCHOOL AND SAN ROQUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL BOTH IN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO
