**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH THRU
SECRETARY FRANCISCO T. DUQUE III TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF QUARANTINE FACILITIES INTENDED FOR COVID-
19 PATIENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF
ORIENTAL MINDORO**

"WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall promote health and safety;

"WHEREAS, on April 20, 2021, the Department of Health-RITM certified laboratory released that there are 953,106 total number of COVID-19 cases in the Philippines since the pandemic had started, the 2,324 cases recorded came from the Province of Oriental Mindoro;

"WHEREAS, with COVID- 19 dominating every nation as the new normal, it has been difficult for most of the people who were required to be quarantined because of their exposure from the virus, it is imperative and advisable for every government to provide quarantine areas that are clean, secured, has complete facilities, and has good environment or surroundings that are not stressful more importantly to those who were infected of the coronavirus;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao is a 3rd class Municipality hounded with financial constraints located at the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro, has a population of 39, 107 based on 2015 census, 25 percent of which are indigenous people called Hanunuo Mangyan, has a municipal government that uplift the general health condition of the people;

"WHEREAS, it has been a challenge to the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to implement the COVID- 19 quarantine protocols because of its exhausted fund, unfortunately it is using classrooms and/or barangay halls as quarantine areas that put so much complaints and troublesome to the COVID-19 patients and their close contact persons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Request the Department of Health thru Secretary Francisco T. Duque III to allocate funds for the construction of quarantine facilities intended for COVID- 19 patients in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro.
