RESOLUTION NO. 20-06-324

EARNESTLY REQUESTING SENATOR CYNTHIA A. VILLAR TO GRANT VEGETABLE SEEDS TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO ITS COMPONENT BARANGAYS AS LIVELIHOOD PROJECT

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao has a tropical climate type suitable for farming, it consists of 15 barangays and has a total agricultural land area of 10, 325.80 hectares planted with various varieties of agricultural products such as rice, corn, onions, garlic and different kinds of vegetables and fruits. There are approximately 6, 016 registered individuals employed in the agricultural sector;

"WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 the Municipality of Bulalacao is considered as a 3rd class Municipality located in the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro and based on the 2015 census it has a population of 39,107 people where almost 25 percent of it are indigenous people called Hanunuo-Mangyans;

"WHEREAS, while farming and fishing are the primary means of income and livelihood of Bulalacaonons, upland farmers particularly the Mangyans are at the disadvantaged condition as they would only rely on upland agriculture for living;

"WHEREAS, assistance such as the provision of vegetable seeds would help them secure food and would somehow facilitate livelihood opportunities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT, RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: earnestly request Senator Cynthia A. Villar to grant vegetable seeds to the Local Government of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to be distributed to its component barangays as livelihood project.






