**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE REGIONAL EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, ANTONIO G. GERUNDIO, CESO III, D.P.A., DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE, MIMAROPA TO CONDUCT EVALUATION AND INSPECTION IN THE PROPOSED AREA FOR ARMOUR ROCK EXTRACTION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**“WHEREAS**, stone quarrying is the multistage process by which rock is extracted from the ground and crushed to produce aggregate which is then screened into sizes required for immediate use or for further processing;

**“WHEREAS**, armour stone which is also called as quarry stone is generally the raw materials needed to build houses, hospitals, schools and for various infrastructural projects where life would be certainly be more basic and less comfortable than is presently experience by the world today;

**“WHEREAS**, Barangays Maujao, San Francisco and Milagrosa in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro have large deposits of armour rocks needed to be extracted in order to use the areas into agricultural purposes suited to be planted with corn, peanuts and varieties of root crops providing more opportunities for the residents thereat to earn additional income for the family;


**“WHEREAS**, the three barangays mentioned above had expressed their willingness through a barangay resolution that armour rocks thereat be extracted for more productive uses of the areas; **Now, therefore, be it**
