**RESOLUTION NO. 20-06-297**

**EARNESTLY REQUESTING MR. ELIZER S. SALILIG, MFT, REGIONAL DIRECTOR, BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR) MIMAROPA TO GRANT 16 UNITS OF MOTORIZED BOAT/BANCA INTENDED FOR THE SMALL-SCALE FISHERMEN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**"WHEREAS**, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) is a government agency under the Department of Agriculture responsible for the development, improvement, management and conservation of the country's fisheries and aquatic resources, it was reconstituted as a line bureau by virtue of Republic Act No. 8550 ( Philippine Fisheries Code 1998);

**"WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bulalacao, has established two Marine Protected Areas (MPA) to help protect important habitats and various species of marine life and assist in restoring the productivity of the oceans and avoid further degradation. The MPA are also sites for scientific study and generate income through tourism and sustainable fishing;

**"WHEREAS**, Bulalacao, has ten (10) coastal barangays whose major source of income of the residents is fishing. It is acclaimed as the fishing capital of the Province of Oriental Mindoro transporting large volume of fish and other marine products to nearby provinces and Metro Manila;

**"WHEREAS**, marginalized fishermen are now given free and the privilege to fish around the municipal waters because "panghulong" and other commercial fishing vessels are prohibited to fish in accordance with the implementation of several municipal ordinance in an effort to safeguard the local fishing activities of the local folks;

"WHEREAS, poverty exists in small-scale fishing in Bulalacao because majority of them do not own a motorized boat to use, unfortunately most of them need to rent a boat for fishing, thus the provision of a motorized fishing boat shall be of great importance and valuable on their daily fishing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To; Earnestly request Mr. Elizer S. Salilig, MFT, Regional Director, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) MIMAROPA to grant 16 units of motorized boat/banca intended for the small-scale fishermen in the municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.
