REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE-PHILIPPINE RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT TO GRANT AT LEAST TWO HUNDRED MILLION PESOS (PHP200,000,000.00) WORTH OF ONION COLD STORAGE FACILITY TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, a 3rd class municipality with a population of 39,107 based on 2015 census, has 15 barangays and total agricultural land area of 10,325.80 hectares with 6,016 registered individuals employed in the agricultural sector, it has a tropical climate type conducive to planting of staple crops such as rice and corn including garlic, onions and varieties of vegetables and fruits being transported to Manila and nearby provinces;

"WHEREAS, next to rice production, Bulalacao is popular in producing large volume of onions where all efforts are exerted to have these planted every year because of its huge economic returns bringing hope and inspiration to the family to uplift their standard of living;

"WHEREAS, during harvesting season of onion in Bulalacao, the farmers are experiencing massive losses in their earnings because of the low commodity prices being offered to their products that could not compensate in the high cost of pesticides and fertilizers they spent;

"WHEREAS, it is ideal to have an onion cold storage facility that can stored the onion products up to ten months without deterioration which the farmers can sell their products in a later season where they can have a just and/or high commodity prices to properly pay off all their hard work and expenses;

"WHEREAS, a progressive agriculture is quite evident in Bulalacao but it is still striving for improvement and sustainability, its Local Government Unit understands the needs and circumstances of its farmers in providing best quality agricultural products without compromising their own income, thus the provision of onion cold storage facility would certainly ensure Bulalacao farmers the confidence to produce more and will result to upholding the social economic status of the community as a whole; Now, therefore, be it...


