PARAGAS, CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER TO ALLOCATE FIFTY MILLION PESOS (PHP50M) TO BE USED FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR STREETLIGHTS FROM SITIO CAVILLAN, BARANGAY NASUCOB GOING TO BULALACAO BAY PARK AND RORO PORT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**


