KINDLY FOLLOW-UP WITH THE MANAGEMENT OF MT EMPRESS THE
ALLOCATION OF FUNDS NEEDED FOR THE CONDUCT OF EMERGENCY
RESPONSE AND RESCUE DURING THE OCCURRENCE OF OIL SPILL IN
THE COASTAL AREAS OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2023 the oil tanker MT Princess Empress
carrying 800,000 liters of industrial fuel oil sank off Naujan, Oriental Mindoro
caused by engine trouble (overheating), based on the experts, more or less
36,000 hectares of coral reefs, mangroves and sea grasses were possibly
affected that led to prohibit fishing activities on contaminated coastal areas;

WHEREAS, on March 06, 2023, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of
Oriental Mindoro approved the resolution declaring the State of Calamity in the
77 coastal barangays from 9 municipalities of the province namely Naujan,
Pola, Pinamalayan, Gloria, Bansud, Bongabong, Roxas, Mansalay and
Bulalacao;

WHEREAS, the damage cost and losses due to oil spill are about to
breach the PhP1 Billion mark according to data from Bureau of Fisheries and
Aquatic Resources, that both the national and provincial government has
fervently monitoring the situation since the widespread of the oil spill to the
affected coastal areas of the province;


"WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro thru the good and hardworking Governor Humerlito "Bonz" Dolor with the help of the concerned government agencies continuously provide supports such as livelihood interventions, food and relief assistance, and clean-up assistance, recommendations on fishing bans and analyzing water and seafood for contaminants to protect the public from hazards caused by the oil spill and to address the needs of affected fisherfolk and their families;


"WHEREAS, with the intentness on this matter, this Sanggunian is humbly asking the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro to kindly coordinate with the management of MT Princess and follow-up the allocation of funds needed for the conduct of Emergency Response and Rescue during the occurrence of oil spill in the coastal areas of the Municipality of Bulalacao; Now, therefore be it...

Dolor to kindly follow-up with the management of MT Princess the allocation of funds needed for the conduct of Emergency Response and Rescue during the occurrence of the oil spill in the coastal areas of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro,






