

ORDINANCE NO. 44

MODIFYING ARTICLE H OF THE REVISED REVENUE CODE OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO, 1992, PROVISIONS ON THE REGISTRATION OF FISHING BOATS AND MOTORBOATS OF THREE (3) TONNAGE OR BELOW

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. Article H of the Revised Revenue Code of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, 1992 provisions on the registration of fishing boats and motorboats with three (3) tonnage or below is hereby modified to read as follows:

" Section 5H.01. Imposition of Fees. There shall be collected the following annual registration fees from the owner of each fishing boats and motorboats of three (3) tons or less being operated in this municipality in the amount indicated hereunder:

- a) Motorized fishing boat or fishing boat two (2) tons but not more than three (3) tons . . . ₱1,000.00
- b) Motorized fishing boat or fishing boat one (1) ton but not more than two (2) tons . . . 700.00
- c) Motorized fishing boats or motorboats with less than one (1) tonnage 500.00
- d) Non-motorized fishing boat or watercrafts 50.00

Section 5H.02. Time and Manner of Payment. The registration fee imposed herein shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer within the first twenty (20) days of January of every year. For boats acquired after the first twenty (20) days of January, the registration fee shall be paid without penalty within the first twenty (20) days following its acquisition.

Section 5H. 03. Surcharge for late payment. Failure to pay the fee prescribed in this Article within the time required shall subject the taxpayer to a surcharge of twenty-five (25%) percent of the original amount of fees due, such surcharge to be paid at the same time and in the same manner as the original fee due.

Section 5H. 04. Administrative Provisions. The Municipal Treasurer shall keep a registry of all registered fishing boats, motorboats or watercrafts which shall include information such as, name and address of the owner, the registry number which shall also be printed on the front side of the boat by the operators according to the barangay they originated; and

such other necessary informations. A list of all registered boats or watercrafts shall be submitted by the Municipal Treasurer to the Business Permit Licensing and Inspection Division, Office of the Mayor copy furnished the Office of the Coast Guard concerned.


Section 5H. 05. Penalty. Any violation of the Provisions of this Article shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) but not more than Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) or imprisonment of not less than one (1) month but not more than six (6) months or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court."

SECTION 2. All ordinance inconsistent hereof are hereby repealed, modified accordingly;

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting;
