

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF GARBAGE, FILTH AND OTHER WASTE MATTERS IN THE PUBLIC PLACES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO AND IMPOSING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. REGULATED ACTS. No person shall litter or throw garbage, filth or other waste matters of whatever kind, in public places and other place not duly designated by the Sangguniang Bayan as a garbage disposal area;

SEC. 2. DEFINITION. As used in this Ordinance -

"Public place" refers to any place to which the public has access including streets, highways, parks, plazas, alleys, sidewalks, esteros, canals and such other place open to the public.

SEC. 3. RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All educational and other similar institutions, whether public or private, all commercial and industrial establishments such as hotles, restaurants, hospitals, cinema houses, public markets, department stores, groceries and the like; all public conveyances; all residential houses; and all other similar establishments shall undertake the cleaning of their own estate, yards and immediate premises.
2. All garbage, filth and other waste matters shall be placed in a proper receptacle for the collection and disposal thereof by garbage collectors.
3. The Municipal Health Officer shall issue the necessary additional rules and regulations.


SECTION 4. PENALTY. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) but not to exceed One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) or imprisonment of one (1) month or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court, without prejudiced to the imposition of a higher penalty under the provisions of PD 825 and other laws. If the violator is a corporation, firm, or other corporate entities, the penalty shall be imposed upon the president, manager, director or persons responsible for its operation.

SEC. 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances inconsistent hereof are hereby repealed, modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting.
