" RESOLUTION NO. 95-10-068

EARNESTLY REQUESTING PROVINCIAL AGRICULTURIST, RODOLFO VALDEZ, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, CALAPAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO, TO ALLOCATE 1,000 PIECES OF GRAFTED MANGO SEED-LINGS TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO

"WHEREAS, the climatic condition of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is not unlike to that of the province of Guimaras where the largest volume of mango fruit for export is being produced;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Government, aware of the need to address the problems concerning proper environmental management, has initiated projects geared toward the preservation and protection of our ecology specifically through reforestation program;

"WHEREAS, in pursuing this task, several varieties of trees such as mahogany, germilina, coconut and mango where either planted directly by the municipal government or distributed to the rural folks residing at the far flung barangays;

"WHEREAS, this Body, cognizant of the fact that any programs addressed at arresting the continuous deterioration of our environment must be coupled with the corresponding program promoting the quality of life of human individuals;

"WHEREAS, the planting of mango trees on the heavily denuded areas would both served the idea of environmental protection and the need to provide the individual with the possible source of income in the instant years to come considering the growing market and the popularity of this particular fruit among countries of the world;

"WHEREAS, it is laudable that the idea of promoting environmental protection and providing livelihood to all marginal farmers is likewise pursued by the Provincial Government through the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist, Now therefore, be it;

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To earnestly request the Provincial Agriculturist, Rodolfo Valdez, Department of Agriculture, Calapan, Oriental Mindoro, to allocate 1,000 pieces of grafted mango seedlings to the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to let copies of this resolution be furnished Mr. Roldolfo Valdez, Provincial Agriculturist Department of Agriculture, Calapan, Oriental Mindoro
