REQUESTING HON. JESUS P. GARCIA SR., SECRETARY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TO OPEN AN OFFICE IN CHARGE OF ACCEPTING AND PAYMENTS OF TELEGRAPHIC TRANSFER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is located in the southernmost tip of the island of Mindoro with about 30,000 population;

"WHEREAS, the nearest available and accessible telegraphic transfer office is in the Municipality of Roxas, Oriental Mindoro, about 54 kilometers north of this Municipality;

"WHEREAS, the Travel Time and transportation expenses incurred to send or withdraw telegraphic transfers in Roxas town is time consuming and very expensive and an added burden on this part of the business, private and public sector in general of this locality;

"WHEREAS, within our midst are commercial fishermen, cooperatives, farmers and students commuting daily to and from various places carrying large sum of money which considering the rising criminality in the country posed a danger on their lives and valuables;


"WHEREAS, in recent years, official reports from the PNP Headquarters, bus hold-ups occurred between the Municipality of Roxas and Mansalay town. The same source have also reported jeepney passengers were held at bay between Bulalacao and Mansalay town and their belongings, moneys and other valuables were taken by the holduppers;


