ORDINANCE NO. 076

REQUIRING ALL GRADUATING INTERMEDIATE PUPILS AND SECONDARY STUDENTS AND ALL APPLICANTS FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE TO PLANT TREES AT THE DESIGNATED AREAS AS A PRE-REQUISITE FOR GRADUATION OR GRANT MARRIAGE LICENSE, AS THE CASE MAY BE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. Every graduating intermediate pupil and secondary student and every couple applying for marriage license is hereby required to plant at least three (3) fruit-bearing, ornamental or durable trees herein designated as a pre-requisite for graduation or grant of marriage license, as the case may be;

SECTION 2. The following areas are hereby designated for the purpose, to wit:

- i. Roadsides of national highway
- ii. Roadsides of provincial highway
- iii. Roadsides of municipal road
- iv. Roadsides of barangay road
- v. Riverbanks
- vi. School campuses
- vii. Watersheds, greenbelts or parks
- viii. In any land of public domain that the Municipal Mayor at his discretion shall designate.

SECTION 3. Compliance with this ordinance shall be attested through the certification by the Barangay Captains for the applicants for marriage license or by the Head Teachers in case of the graduating students or pupils. It shall be stated in the certificate the following facts and information:

- i. Name of applicant, subject and date of application;
- ii. Number and kind of trees planted;
- iii. The site where the trees were planted;

The Barangay Captain or the Head Teacher shall further require the applicants to provide the planted materials with appropriate tree guards before he issues a certification therefor;

SECTION 4. Willful and malicious failure of any officer to implement this ordinance may be meted disciplinary action;

SECTION 5. Within one (1) month after the approval of this ordinance, the Municipal Mayor shall convene Special Committee as herein provided for. The said Committee shall formulate

and issue the appropriate rules and regulations necessary for the efficient and effective implementation of any and all provisions of this ordinance;


The Committee shall be composed of the following:

1. The Municipal Agricultural Officer who shall be the Chairman;
2. The Municipal Civil Registrar who shall be the Vice-Chairman
3. The District Supervisor;
4. One representative from each of the following:
 - i. The Sangguniang Bayan
 - ii. The Liga ng mga Barangay
 - iii. The Sangguniang Kabataan
 - iv. The Philippine National Police
 - v. The CENRO

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting.
