

OPLE, SENATE PRESIDENT PRO-TEMPORE, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, 2ND FLOOR MARBELLA BLDG., 2071 ROXAS BOULEVARD, MANILA TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BUILDING THAT SHALL SERVE AS THE CENTER FOR THE SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the State in recognition of the elderly citizens enacted Republic Act Numbered 7432 in order to motivate, encourage and maximize senior citizens capability to partake in the task of nation building and to mobilize their families and the communities where they live and to reaffirm the valued Filipino tradition of caring for the old members of the family and the community in general;

"WHEREAS, the enactment of this law is a meaningful State management intervention to operationalize the concepts of productive citizenry, respect and care for the elderly;

"WHEREAS, under the law, cities and municipalities are directed to establish an Office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) to assist senior citizens in availing themselves of the mutually beneficial privileges solely intended for them, however financial constraint might hamper the noble objective;

"WHEREAS, the enshrined functions, responsibilities and privileges outlined for the senior citizens can be given flesh fully if the members actively participate in their meetings where their ideas are ventilated, weighed and crystallized into a well-planned program where the center for their exclusive use is an obvious necessity; Now, therefore, be it


