REQUESTING THE ABS/CBN-CHANNEL 2 TO COVER IN ONE OF THEIR TV PROGRAMS THE LAUNCHING OF THE FILARIASIS HEALTH CARE PROGRAM AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Filariasis is a chronic parasitic infection caused by nematode parasites affecting people both in rural and urban areas with poor health practices. The disease is transmitted to a person through the bites from infected female mosquitoes primarily found in areas wherein the environment favors the propagation of specific insect vectors of the parasite;

"WHEREAS, it is sad to know that Barangay Benli, Municipality of Bulalacao is endemic of filariasis which were confirmed positive both by microscopy and physical findings;

"WHEREAS, to arrest the problem, the Municipal Government of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro initiated the Filariasis Health Fair Orientation on January 16, 2001 and proposed to launch the Filariasis Health Care Program on February 20, 2001 which aim to control if not totally eradicate the spread of the disease;


"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is a Pro-Poor Municipality with limited funds that it could not readily sustain the long term treatment of filariasis to which viewing it in the TV Program particularly by the ABS/CBN of Channel-2 is believed to gain support from the public through financial assistance;


