RESOLUTION NO. 05-01-006

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE ARNAN C. PANALIGAN, PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR TO ASSIGN SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF PAPASAKA TEACHERS AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO PREFERABLY THOSE WHO WERE GRADUATES AND BONA FIDE RESIDENTS OF THIS TOWN

"WHEREAS, Section 17, Article II of the 1986 Constitution provides that the State shall give priority of education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerates social progress and promote total human liberation and development, along with this is the understanding that the State shall assigned the highest budgetary allocation to education and that basic education shall be made available to all;

"WHEREAS, on account of the current growth in the population rate of the country, the same reflects with the growth of the population of the studentry; furthermore, such trends is vividly exemplified in the case of Bulalacao Elementary School, wherein despite the institutionalization of several primary and elementary schools at the constituents barangays suffers from the overflowing influx of new pupils;

"WHEREAS, justifying this Resolution, this Sangguniang Bayan is prompted to request the Government to lodge this clamor for sufficient teachers to be funded by the Provincial Government Unit under PAPANAKA;


