**"WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bulalacao is located in the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro was declared as Pro-Poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 has a population of approximately twenty percent hanunuo mangyans who because of poverty could hardly cope up with their daily basic needs;

**"WHEREAS**, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro was once a tropical rainforest part of the Island of Mindoro but sad to see that after sometimes this beautiful town becomes devastated of trees caused by massive illegal logging, rampant kaingin system and commercialization of charcoal;


