MARCOS, JR., PRESIDENT-ELECT, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES THROUGH THE NATIONAL ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATION TO INCLUDE IN ITS SITIO ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAM THE ENERGIZATION OF DIFFERENT SITIOS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**"WHEREAS**, for over the past decades, our Government has always been prioritizing the rural electrification, it strongly believes that the provision of electric services will produce more opportunities to improve the socio-economic growth of the marginalized sectors, and it will have a greater access to basic services and better infrastructure for rural development;

**"WHEREAS**, Bulalacao is a third class Municipality located at the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro, it has a Municipal Government that aims to establish an efficient local organization which is responsive to the needs of the locality and effectively manages its resources to sustain growth and development;

**"WHEREAS**, Bulalacao has fifteen barangays where many of its sitios as mentioned below has still no source of electricity that is essentially needed to daily living of its communities, these sitios in each barangay are the following, to wit:

1. Barangay Bagong Sikat- Baluguhan, Papakan, Badyang and Upper Centro.
2. Barangay Balatasan- Lagara, Bislig, Gamot, Recudo, Burbo, Punta Pandan, and Magayad.
3. Barangay Benli- Bugnay, Parakasoy, Waring, Abay, Ugyong, Sanigo, Balagway, Hamloy, Balang, Balditan, Silda, Banti-ano, Paoy and Tuong.

4. Barangay Cabugao- Lidong, Buren-ay, Pale, Cassava, Bagong Purok, Lanas, Mosuit, Balgawe, Oplic, and Baluguhan.
5. Barangay Cambunang- Purok Candahon, Purok Curing-ot, Napisian, Purok Lower Lang-at, Purok Balang, and Purok Tuway.
6. Barangay Campaasan- Barumbong and Talisay(Upper part).
7. Barangay Maasin- Purok 3 and Purok 4.
8. Barangay Maujao- Recudo, Puting Bato, Upper San Miguel, Camarin, Riverside, Upper Lambok, Barubuan, Badyang, and Aplaya Sauton.
9. Barangay Milagrosa- Balwa, Hinagdan, and Alimango.
10. Barangay Nasucob- Lawaan, Bangkuris, Kalas-an, Sue, Bato, Mabunga, Cocoped, Tagwak, Bayog, Suryawon, Araang, Lagnas, and Curing-ot.
11. Barangay Poblacion- Caratao(Tabuk 4).
12. Barangay San Francisco- Tinape and Alimawan(some part).
13. Barangay San Isidro- Bagong Silang.
14. Barangay San Juan- Matabangcal, Bangkal, Proper, San Vicente, Quipanglao, and Sta. Rosa II.
15. Barangay San Roque- Agong, Danawan, Bar-aw, Bahungan, Talisayan, Buyayao, Arasaas, Lagnas, Pukanin, Udal, and Tagumpay.

“WHEREAS, to have all the sitios in this municipality get energized, it would not only provide ease and comfort but it would also instill to the mind of every Bulalacaonon especially those which are located in geographically isolated and depressed area that no one is left behind in the struggle for development of this municipality; Now, therefore, be it...
