RESOLUTION REQUESTING LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) TO EXTEND TECHNICAL, TECHNOLOGICAL AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO FOR POSSIBLE OPENING OF A DRIVING SCHOOL IN THE BULALACAO TECHNICAL VOCATIONAL COLLEGE (BTVC)

"WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Office (LTO) is a sectoral agency of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) by virtue of Executive Order No. 125 and 125A dated April 13, 1987 and Executive Order No. 226 dated July 25, 1987, tasked to register motor vehicles, issue driver's/conductor's licenses and permits, enforce transportation laws, rules and regulations and adjudicate apprehension cases;

"WHEREAS, the Bulalacao Technical Vocational College (BTVC) is an institution accredited by TESDA that offers Technical and Vocational Education and Training Programs (TVET) under the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), it is located at Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro;

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is on the borderline to being an agro-eco-tourism destination in the Province of Oriental Mindoro that collaborative hard works from both private and government sectors are applied and gathered together to deliver positive outcome;

"WHEREAS, at this present time, Bulalacao has no driving school or center that can deliver comprehensive driving education and training programs to its people, this would likewise beneficial to BTVC as it would provide additional course and income;

"WHEREAS, the opening of a driving school or center in this municipality will introduce integrated system of driver instructions from beginner to actual driving license and beyond, and would also ensure that road user behavior will be closely in conformity with road safety requirements under present-day traffic regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To; request Land Transportation Office (LTO) to extend technical, technological and financial assistance to the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro in the possible opening of a driving school in Bulalacao Technical and Vocational College (BTVC).




