### RESOLUTION NO. 18-09-235

RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING PCSUPT TOMAS C. APOLINARIO, REGIONAL DIRECTOR, REGION IV-B, PNP AND PSSUPT CHRISTOPHER C. BIRUNG TO IMMEDIATELY RELIEVE PCI LORENCE P. BATALLER FROM HIS ASSIGNMENT AS OFFICER-IN-CHARGE OF BULALACAO MUNICIPAL POLICE STATION

“WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, the Philippine National Police and the Community are dynamic partners in resolving and abating crimes specifically the proliferation of illegal drugs in the locality;

“WHEREAS, the Bulalacao Municipal Police Station (BMPS) has able and active police personnel headed by an Officer-in-Charge (OIC) in the name PCI Lorence P. Bataller;

“WHEREAS, it is of public knowledge that the priority concern of the National Government headed by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte is to abate the proliferation of illegal drugs in the country which is being implemented primarily by the Philippine National Police;

“WHEREAS, since the assumption of PCI Bataller as OIC of the BMPS there is no record that will show an accomplishment in the implementation of laws pertaining to illegal drugs;

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is not declared a Drug-Free Municipality, thus, proliferation of illegal drugs is still apparent in the community and the BMPS headed by PCI Bataller has not shown anything to abate it;

**"WHEREAS**, in order to off-set the situation that there is no accomplishment on illegal drugs, PCI Bataller has resulted to arrests and imprisonment of poor people violating petty crimes like in fishing and agriculture;

**"WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao received letters and petitions from fishermen and farmers alleging that there were illegal arrests committed by the police and requesting that PCI Bataller be immediately relieved from his assignment as OIC of the BMPS;

**"WHEREAS**, an incident of negligence which may be considered as violation of criminal and administrative laws happened last 03 September 2018 when a detainee charged with rape case escaped while in detention at the BMPS;

**"WHEREAS**, it has come to the knowledge of the officials of the Local Government of Bulalacao that the majority of Police Officers assigned at the BMPS are questioning the organizational management style of PCI Bataller as Officer-in-Charge;

**"WHEREAS**, as mandated by law, the Municipal Mayors are empowered to exercise operational supervision and control over the PNP units in their respective jurisdictions and authorized to choose the Chief of Police from a list of five (5) eligible officers recommended by the Provincial Police Director, recommend the transfer, reassignment or detail of PNP members outside their respective city/town residences; and recommend from a list of eligible officers the appointment of new PNP members to be assigned to their cities and municipalities;

**WHEREAS**, in the case of the assignment of PCI Bataller as OIC of BMPS, the Municipal Mayor was not consulted nor provided with the list of eligible officers that he may recommend as Chief of Police or Officer-in-Charge of the Bulalacao Municipal Police Station as provided in National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) issuances;


**NOW THEREFORE, RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To:**  
Request to PCSUPT TOMAS C. APOLINARIO, Regional Director, Region IV-B, PNP and PSSUPT CHRISTOPHER C. BIRUNG, Provincial Director, Oriental Mindoro, PNP the following;


1. That, PCI LORENCE P. BATALLER be immediately relieved from his assignment as Officer-in-Charge of the Bulalacao Municipal Police Station; and,
2. That, the Municipal Mayor of the Bulalacao be allowed to recommend from a list of five (5) eligible officers submitted by the PNP as replacement for the position that may be vacated in view of the relief from post of PCI Lorence P. Bataller.


