ORDINANCE NO. 6

REQUIRING OWNERS OF MOTOR BANCA, RESIDENCE OR NON-RESIDENCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO USING DIVIDING EQUIPMENTS AND OTHER PARAPHERNALIS (CALANDRA) IN CATHING FISH, GATHERING SHELLS, SEA CUCUMBER (BALATAN) AND OTHER SEA FOOD TO PAY TO THE MUNICIPAL TREASURER THE CORRESPONDING FEES FOR EVERY PERMIT ISSUE BY THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR AND SHALL PROVIDE FINES AND PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION HEREOF

WHEREAS, it has been noticed that owners of some motor banca of residence and non-resident of this municipality are using diving equipment and other paraphernalias in cathing fish, gathering shells, sea cucumber (balatan) and other sea foods;

WHEREAS, in order to raise the revenue of this municipality and to comply owners of motor banca to pay Mayor's Permit before using the above-mentioned diving equipment and other paraphernalias, the Sangguniang Bayan hereby Ordinance, that;

SECTION 1, Owners of Motor banca, using diving equipment and other paraphernalias (Capandra) in cathing fish, gathering shells, sea cucumber and other sea foods are hereby required to pay to the Municipal Treasurer or his authorize representatives the corresponding fees enumerated hereunder for every permit issued by the Municipal Mayor;

- a) Application fee. . . . . ₱ 20.00 per quarter
- b) Mayor's Permit . . . . . ₱100.00 " "

SECTION 2. Application for Permit to operate motor banca with diving equipment (Capandra) shall be done quarterly and to be renewed after the lapse of each thereof;

SECTION 3. Diving equipment mentioned in Section 1 hereof shall be used for legal purpose only;


SECTION 4. Violation of the provision of this Ordinance or parts hereof, shall subject the offender to a fine of not less than five hundred pesos (₱ 500,00) to not more than one thousand Pesos (₱ 1,000,00) or imprisonment from six months to one year or both such and imprisonment and confiscation of the paraphernalias and diving equipment at the discretion of the court;

SECTION 5, Ordinance or Ordinances, inconsistent with the Provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 6, This ordinance shall take effect immediately ten (10) days after its approval . . . . .
