

ORDINANCE NO. 019-B

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A COMPREHENSIVE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

SECTION 1. TITLE. The title of this Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Implementing a Comprehensive Solid Waste Management System in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;

SEC. 2. DEFINITION. As used in this Ordinance –

- a. "Comprehensive Solid Waste Management"- is a technological approach aimed to recycle wastes into a useful ones for the promotion and attainment of a zero waste strategy.
- b. "Garbage" – refers to anything that is rubbish, trash, discarded and worthless.
- c. "Biodegradable wastes"- anything that is capable of decaying or decomposing such as ash, dead animals, manure and etc.
- d. "Non-Biodegradable wastes"- anything that is not capable of decaying and cannot be absorbed by the environment such as cellophanes, plastics, rubbers, used oils, poisonous chemicals, bottles, cans, etc.

SEC. 3. RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- a. All educational and other similar institutions, whether private or public; all commercial and industrial establishments such as hotels, restaurants, hospitals, cinema houses, public market, department stores, groceries and the like; all public conveyances; all residential houses; and all other similar establishments shall undertake the cleaning of their own estate, yards and immediate premises.
- b. All garbage, filth and other waste matters shall be properly separated, the biodegradable from the non-biodegradable be placed in a proper and separate receptacles made for the purpose and must be properly disposed to avoid pollution.

- c. The Municipal Health Officer shall issue the necessary additional rules and regulations.


SECTION 4. PENALTY. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than P500.00 but not exceed P1,000.00 or imprisonment of one month or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. If the violator is a corporation, firm or other corporate entities, the penalty shall be imposed upon the president, manager, director or persons responsible for its operation.

SEC. 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances inconsistent hereof are hereby repealed, modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting.
