### SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-03-002-A

**SPECIAL ORDINANCE ADOPTING LIGTAS BUNTIS 2005 CAMPAIGN OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**Sponsor:** Councilor Rosalinda M. Cabagay  
**Chairman:** Committee on Health

**BE.IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

**SECTION 1. STATEMENT OF POLICY.** Considering the alarming result of the National Demographic Health Survey, revealing that as significant percentage (17%) of Filipino women want to practice family planning but are unavail for the (80%) of the non-planning users do not have the opportunity to discuss the practice with health workers in the field or at the health facility,

**SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES.** As an strategic campaign to dramatically increase the visibility and accessibility of Family Planning, this Ordinance aims:

- i. To answer the seemingly inadequate availability of family planning and safe motherhood information and services, results in most cases to unwanted pregnancies and unsafe deliveries, "an unwanted pregnancy affects the health and the socio-economic well being of the mother, infant and the family as a whole,"
- ii. To make the Local Government Units provide significant rules in providing a wide range of services for the welfare of their constituents specially preventive and promotive health care services, including Family Planning and Maternal Care services;




- iii. To re-energize the health workers in reaching and providing quality care to women and couples as a major step towards health development. Furthermore, the Philippine Government as one of the signatories to the Millennium Declaration in September 2000 affirms commitments towards attaining its goals (Millennium Development Goals) which include reduction in infant and child mortality as well as improvement in maternal health;


**SEC. 3.** The Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro hereby adopts the "Ligtas Buntis 2005 Campaign" as a nationwide response to address the needs of men, women and couples to plan their families which have not been met due to deficiencies in social structures and health care systems as well as problems on availability, accessibility and affordability of Family Planning services. It likewise encourages the full support and collaboration of communities, barangays, health workers, centers for health development, Population Commission, PhilHealth, NGO's, private sectors and others partners for the success of Ligtas Buntis 2005 Campaign;


**SECTION 4. Effectivity.** This special ordinance shall take effect after its approval.


