"WHEREAS, a great sense of loss is felt by his townmates over the demise of "Kuya Tito" as he was fondly called to by his friends for he was one of the most respected person in the locality due to his strong dedication and valuable contributions in his line of duty in his desire of bringing the best service to the people of Bulalacao.

"WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro together with all Municipal Officials and employees desire to express its profound sympathy and condolence to the family of the late Agustin V. Aguilar in their hour of sorrow and bereavement.
