EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE BARTOLOME L. MARASIGAN, SR., PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR TO IMMEDIATELY FILL-UP THE POSITION OF MEDICAL OFFICER IV AT THE BULALACAO COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, It is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other services available to all people at affordable cost, priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sickly, elderly, disabled, women and children should be recognized;

“WHEREAS, to implement the aforementioned constitutional mandate and pursuant to Administrative Order No. 277 dated June 25, 1996, the Municipal Government of Bulalacao appropriated the necessary amount to grant its poor constituents a membership to the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) to enable them to avail free hospitalization;


“WHEREAS, Philhealth beneficiaries at Bulalacao could not seek medical services from the Bulalacao Community Hospital since it is not accredited as Philhealth hospital since it does not comply with the requirement of at least two (2) permanent physicians;

“WHEREAS, cognizant for the welfare of these Philhealth beneficiaries who are primarily composed of the poor and the senior citizens, it is earnestly requested that the position of Medical Officer IV be immediately filled-up in order to be qualified and accredited as Philhealth Hospital. Now, therefore, be it
