RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HARIBON FOUNDATION TO CONSIDER THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO IN RAINFORESTATION ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCATES (ROAD) 2020 PROJECT

“WHEREAS, due to the irresponsible devastation to our natural resources caused upon by the massive illegal logging, rampant kaingin system of farming and irreparable damage caused by the commercialization of the immoral charcoal production that exploits the poor particularly the Mangyans who are bereft of employment and decent means of living, having no alternative, sadly in local vernacular **“ay kapit sa patalim”** for them to survive in an economically deprived society where hope cause the highest price to be paid;

“WHEREAS, it is a melancholic observation that this lowly town of Bulalacao despite the fact that it had been once a tropical rainforest part of the Island of Mindoro where boars, deers and tamaraws freely roamed and naturally and other wild species, now endangered of extinction together with other floras and faunas peculiarity found to the beautiful Island of Mindoro are now vanishing to the disgust of anyone who loves ecology; and understands the significance of an environment habitable for all living things not only for now but decisively of the next generation;

"WHEREAS, cognizant of the alarming effects of El Nino as well as of La Nina which destroy limbs, lives and properties, the Government has to take the necessary measure to adopt preventive measure such as the renewal of our remaining forest reserves, propagation of trees and active implementation of the campaign for a no nonsense advocacy against irresponsible felling of trees rather; the Government through the participation of several private and civic organization may together unite in this noble advocacy;


"WHEREAS, Haribon Foundation Philippines is known and well-praised for its advocacy and implementation of developmental projects and programs geared towards balanced ecology such as that of re-invented the formation of Rainforestation Organization and Advocates (ROAD) 2020 Project aiming that better environmental climate would be reached by year 2020; Now, therefore, be it


