RESOLUCION WITHDRAWING THE SUPPORT OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO PHILCARBON INC. IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCE AND FURTHER REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY THROUGH SECRETARY ALFONSO G. CUSI TO OPEN THE SAME CONTRACT OF SERVICE TO QUALIFIED AND INTERESTED COMPANY

"WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao has been very consistent in encouraging partners to put-up alternative energy source investments here in Bulalacao as it acknowledges the service of electricity as an important tool in steering economic growth towards the achievement of lasting peace and for the general welfare of its constituents;

"WHEREAS, based on a resource assessment report from the Department of Energy, the Island of Mindoro including the Municipality of Bulalacao possesses abundant indigenous renewable energy resources such as wind, where studies have indicated an average wind speed of 7 meters per second and has a potential to start with Wind Power Farm and still have the capability to increase as the power demand requires;

"WHEREAS, Philcarbon Inc. was given a Contract of Service by the Department of Energy to develop wind power renewable energy in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro last six (6) years ago but up to this time no output as to net mass installed to measure wind stability to support the project;


"WHEREAS, the present status of power and energy in Bulalacao is characterized by frequent interruption and shortage, hampers economic activities and discourages business and investments that the development of a wind power renewable energy shall bring hope and inspiration to the people of Bulalacao while confronting the challenges of poverty and climate change;


"WHEREAS, the failure of Philcarbon Inc. to continue the development of wind power project in Bulalacao for unknown reasons brought dismay and dissatisfaction to the people whose light of hope turned-out into nothing but memories; **Now, therefore, be it**


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Withdraw the support of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to Philcarbon Inc. in the development of renewable energy source and further requesting the Department of Energy through Secretary Alfonso G. Cusi to open the same contract of service to qualified and interested company;


