RESOLUTION NO. 21-02-054

RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE REGIONAL EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, MR. ANTONIO G. GERUNDIO, CESO III DPA, DA-RFO-MIMAROPA THROUGH THE PHILIPPINE CENTER FOR POSTHARVEST DEVELOPMENT (PhilMech) TO GRANT 50 UNITS OF ONION SEEDER INTENDED FOR THE ONION FARMERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, within their respective territorial jurisdictions;

“WHEREAS, Bulalacao, a 3rd class municipality is a vast agricultural land, has 15 barangays and with a total agricultural land area of 10,325.80 hectares where 6,016 individuals are employed in the agricultural sector;

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is on the borderline to being an agro-eco-tourism destination in the Province of Oriental Mindoro that collaborative hard works from both private and government sectors are applied and gathered together to deliver positive outcome;

“WHEREAS, the Municipality has a tropical climate type conducive to planting of staple crops such as rice and corn including garlic, onions and varieties of vegetables and fruits transported to Manila and nearby provinces;

“WHEREAS, next to rice production, Bulalacao is popular in producing large volume of onions where all efforts are exerted to have these planted every year because of its huge economic returns bringing hope and inspiration to the family to uplift their standard of living;


"WHEREAS, assistance such as the provision of onion seeders would encourage and support onion farmers to plant more products that would be beneficial not only to their livelihood but also to the local agricultural income;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To; earnestly request the Regional Executive Director, Mr. Antonio G. Gerundio, CESO III DPA, DA-RFO-MIMAROPA through the Philippine Center for Postharvest Development (PhilMech) to grant 50 units of onion seeder intended for the onion farmers in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro.
