



WHEREAS, adopting the KALAHI-CIDDS principles in the implementation of the programs and projects funded out from the Municipal Development Fund and/or other Development Funds is being considered as one of the municipality's best practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro in session assembled, that;

SECTION 1. TITLE – this ordinance shall be known as “An ordinance Institutionalizing and adopting the Municipal Community Driven Development Program (MCDDP) in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, appropriating funds, providing exemption and for other purposes” or cited as Municipal Community Driven and Development Program Ordinance”

SECTION 2. Purpose and Coverage- the purpose of this Ordinance is to uphold the Municipality of Bulalacao's constitutional responsibility to ensure the empowerment of the community, people participation, transparency, accountability, sustainable development, volunteerism, gender sensitivity, reduction of poverty and anti-corrupt mechanism.

This ordinance shall cover the fifteen (15) barangays and its sitios in the Municipality of Bulalacao Oriental Mindoro

SECTION 3. Definition of terms- As used in this ordinance, the following acronyms shall mean:

- 3.2. COA- Commission on Audit
- 3.3. CVs- Community Volunteers
- 3.4. DBM- Department of Budget and Management
- 3.5. DILG- Department of the Interior and Local Government

- 3.8. JMC- Joint memorandum Circular
- 3.9. IRR- Implementing Rules and Regulation
- 3.10. MCDDP – Municipal Community Driven Development Program
- 3.11. MDF- Municipal Development Fund
- 3.12. ODF- Other Development Fund

SECTION 4. General Provisions-

- 4.1. Barangay project against the 20% Development Fund must be under the category of the capital investment and identified within the framework of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No 2011-01. The KALAHI-CIDDS implementing principle is hereby adopted except in the procurement process which is solely the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Bulalacao, provided that the representation of the community volunteers shall be ensured and observed.

- 4.2. Barangay projects chargeable against the other Development Fund, Public Assistance and/or other available Municipal Government Fund may be downloaded to the community account subject to prescribed accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4.3. Implementing rules and regulations (IRR) of the ordinance shall be formulated by the Local Finance Committee, Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer, Municipal Engineer, the Pangulo ng Liga ng mga Barangay and the Chairperson or members of the Committee on Rules and Ordinances of the Sangguniang, sixty (60) days upon its approval.
- 4.4. In coordination with BSPMC, the recipient barangay must lead in the task and assist the functionaries for the implementation of this ordinance
- 4.5. The concerned Local Government Department Officials shall ensure full cooperation in the implementation of this ordinance. Consultation with the Department of Social Welfare and Development and the Commission on Audit is hereby encourage to ensure proper formulation of the IRR.

**SECTION 5. Funding-** All barangay MCDD projects of Bulalacao has a cost of not less than Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php200,000.00) but not more than Five hundred thousand Pesos (Php500,000.00) each. It may be sourced from the Municipal Development Fund, Other Development Fund, Public Assistance and/or other available Municipal Government Fund.

Funds for this purpose shall be included in the 2021 Annual Budget and thereafter. Recipient Barangay should allow at least ten percent (10%) of the approved community sub-project cost. fifty percent (50%) of the ten percent (10%) counterpart may form the cost of labor force available materials in the community.

**SECTION 6. Exemption-** The Barangay in the Municipality of Bulalacao having major projects/programs amounting to more than five hundred thousand (php.500,000.00) funded under the 20% MDF and/or ODF for periodic year is/are hereby exempted in this ordinance.

**SECTION 7. Administrative Provision.** Any officer, employee, or worker of the LGU of Bulalacao who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to pertinent provisions of the Civil Service laws and rules and applicable policies.

**SECTION 8. Repealing Clause.** Any Ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 9. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

**SECTION 10. Effectivity.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.
