

ORDINANCE NO. 15

TO CONSTRUCT THE MUNICIPAL CORAL FOR LARGE CATTLE AND MINOR ANIMALS TO BE IM-  
POUNDED WHILE WAITING FOR BUYERS OR FOR SHIPMENT.

WHEREAS, large cattles and minor animals of this Municipality are being  
shipped to Batangas and Manila;

WHEREAS, before the shipment of large and minor animals the same were  
only tied around the vicinity of the town proper and Campaasan;

WHEREAS, in order to safeguard the health of the people and to regulate  
the tying and impounding large cattle and minor animals, the Sangguniang  
Bayan of Bulalacao, hereby Ordains that:

SECTION 1. Municipal Coral shall be constructed for large cattle and  
minor animals in this Municipality, at Campaasan and other places suitable to  
construct the same before shipment of the same is made;

SECTION 2. All ranchers of Bulalacao, who wish to sell their large ca-  
ttle, persons or buyers of the same are required to impound their animals at  
the Municipal Coral at Campaasan before selling or shipment is made;

SECTION 3. Owner or owners of large cattle and minor animals depositing  
the same in the Municipal Coral shall pay the rate herein enumerated below.

1. Large Cattle - - - - - ₱1.00
2. Minor Animals - - - - - 0.50

SECTION 4. Large cattles and minor animals deposited in the Municipal  
Coral shall be taken care off, by the respective owners;

SECTION 5. Collection of the above fees in the Municipal Coral shall be done  
by the Municipal Treasurer or his duly authorized representatives hereof;

SECTION 6. Violation of this Ordinance or parts hereof, shall be fined  
the amount of ₱50.00 or more but not exceeding ₱200.00 and an imprisonment  
of 15 days or more but not exceeding 30 days or both such fined and imprison-  
ment at the discretion of the court;

SECTION 7. Previews Ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent with the provi-  
sions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
