

RESOLUTION NO. 6
ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11 SERIES OF 1972, IMPOSING TO ANY OWNER OF OWNERS, CORPORATION, OR ANY INDIVIDUAL OF ANY LARGE CATTLE SUCH AS: CARABAO, COWS, HORSES, AND OTHER ASTRAY ANIMALS THAT HAVE BEEN LOOSEN, GRAZED, PUBLIC STREETS, PRIVATE LOTS, OR WITHIN THE AGRICULTURAL ZONE OF ANY PERSON OR INDIVIDUAL AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. ASTRAY ANIMALS. All Astray Animals, tied with rope or without rope that have been loosen, grazed by the owner or owners such as : carabao, cows, horses, etc. regardless of sex owned by any person or individual, corporation, companies, and ranchers caught roaming around the public plaza, public streets, private lots, or within the agricultural zone of any person or given to the Municipal pound and impounded in the coral same, the owner or owners of the said animal or animals shall pay the amount of FIVE (P5.00) for the catcher and FIVE (P5.00) PESOS for the Municipal Government daily beginning the day the said animals are impounded in the Municipal pound until the last day the same be recovered or claimed by the owner or owners with proper payment with the Municipal Treasurer or his authorized representatives;

SECTION 2. Failure of the owner of the animals or animals to recover or claim within fifteen days, the said will be sold for public Auction;

SECTION 3. PENALTY. Any individual or person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by each offense by a fine of not less than TWENTY FIVE (P25.00) PESOS but not exceeding FIFTY (P50.00) PESOS or an imprisonment of not less than FIVE (5) days but not exceeding THIRTY (30) days or both such as fine and an imprisonment at the discretion of the Court;

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. An Ordinance or Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict of this Ordinance is hereby repealed;


SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval;
