ORDINANCE NO. 1

REGULATING ALL OPERATION, DRIVERS OF BUSES, JEEPNEYS, TRUCKS, CARRYING CARGES, OPERATION/PATRONS AND CAPTAINS OF MOTOR BOATS, MOTOR BANCAS, BATILS AND OTHER SEA TRANSPORTATION COMING AND ANCHORING IN THE MUNICIPAL WATERS OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO LOAD AND CARGOES IN THE ARRASTRE OFFICE AT THE MUNICIPAL WHARF AT THE RIVERSIDE, THIS MUNICIPALITY AND SHALL PROVIDE FINES AND PUNISHMENTS FOR EVERY VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Office of Bulalacao Arrest Service and Company is located near the Municipal Wharf at the Riverside, this Municipality;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao has a duly License Arrastre named, "Bulalacao ARRASTS SERVICE AND COMPANY".

WHEREAS, cargoes carried by Buses, Jeepneys, Trucks, motor boats, motor bancas and batils coming and going out of this Municipality are not located and unloaded in the said Municipal Wharf;

WHEREAS, in order to regulate the loading and unloading of cargoes of Jeepneys, buses, trucks, motor boats, motor banca and batils, coming and going out of this Municipality, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, hereby Ordains that:

SECTION 1. All operation, drivers of jeepneys, Buses, trucks, motor boats, motor bancas and batils carrying cargoes coming and out going of this Municipality are ordered to load and unload cargoes at the Arrastre Office at the Municipal Wharf Poblacion, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro for safekeeping, inspection, taxation and for security thereof;


SECTION 2. Bulalacao Arrastre Service and Company shall be liable or responsible for any damages or lost of cargoes that may occur in the Municipal Wharf or in the Arrastre Office hereof;

SECTION 3. Violation of this Ordinance or parts thereof shall be fined the amount of ₱ 50.00 to ₱ 200.00 and an imprisonment of 10 days to 30 days or both such fines and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
