" RESOLUTION NO. 99-02-029

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE TESSIE AQUINO-ORETA, SENATOR, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, TO PLEASE ALLOCATE NECESSARY FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ONE (1) UNIT BUILDING FOR THE BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS (BHW) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, it is now a glaring reality that Barangay Health Workers (BHW), organized to provide basic health services down to the grassroot level, has now become a catalyst of change in our ever-changing society;

"WHEREAS, Section 11, Article XIII, of the Constitution provides that " The State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged sick, elderly, diabled women, and children. The State shall endeavor to provide free medical care to paupers . . . ";

"WHEREAS, the establishment of BHW is included under this provision for its key concepts are "integrated" and "comprehensive" and "affordable" by which integration connotes a unified health delivery system, a combination of public and private sector, and a blend of western medicine and traditional health care modalities whereby comprehensiveness includes health promotion, disease prevention, education and planning. These are premised on the understanding that the high level of health of a people and of a country can be achieved only through a combination of social, economic, political and cultural conditions;


"WHEREAS, the provision of a BHW Building in this Municipality shall provide a proper venue where they could advance their knowledge through trainings and seminars, ventilate their ideas and exchange views and experiences for the promotion of health; Now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Honorable Tessie Aquino-Oreta, Senator, Republic of the Philippines, to please allocate necessary fund for the construction of one (1) unit building for the Barangay Health Workers (BHW) of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;
