INDIGENT RESIDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE
OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1986 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

"WHEREAS, it is sadly observed that life becomes more difficult each day that people could hardly cope up with their basic needs, particularly access to affordable medicines and basic medical services;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Health Office at this Municipality which is manned by one physician, one nurse and a few number of midwives could not fully deliver effective and efficient medical services needed by the residents due to lack of medicines and inavailability of medical equipments;


"WHEREAS, being the Pro-Poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro which is composed of a population of a 20% Hanunuo Mangyans could not immediately augment the appropriation for health services, it, being hounded with financial constraint;



ON MOTION of Councilor Teresita S. Bantugan duly seconded by all members present, foregoing was . . .


