“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao which is situated in the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro suffers a lot of inconvenience and difficulties in going to the capital City of Calapan due to poor road condition;

“WHEREAS, Mansalay to Bulalacao National Road still remains to be rugged and muddy especially during rainy season which poses danger to lives and properties;

“WHEREAS, it is sadly observed that the abovementioned road is the only national road in the whole Province of Oriental Mindoro which remains to be unconcreted to the detriment of the socio-economic status of this Pro-Poor Municipality considering that large volume of agricultural and marine products came from Bulalacao;

“WHEREAS, the concreting of Mansalay to Bulalacao National Road would likewise boosts the eleven (11) Tourist Spot Reserves declared pursuant to Proclamation No. 1801;

speed up the rehabilitation and concreting of Mansalay to Bulalacao National Road at the Province of Oriental Mindoro;


